## REGISTRATION FEE:

A \$100 per family registration fee will be required before the beginning of classes. This is due with registration paperwork before September and is non-refundable. Make this check out to Jeanene Lorey.

## TUITION RATES:

The preschool daily tuition rate is \$15.00 per day, with 80% for 2<sup>nd</sup> enrolled preschool/preK child in the family, the child attending the fewer days.

FOR FIRST/SECOND GRADE (8:30-2:15 daily) monthly rate of \$350 5 day program

Tuition payment is expected on the first class day of each month but no later than the 10<sup>th</sup>. Monthly tuition is based on an average of 4 weeks per month. Over the 10-month school year, taking into account breaks and holidays, monthly average is 20 days of class. Prolonged personal absences due to pre-planned family vacations, unforeseen emergency situations, etc., should be discussed with directors if reduction of regular tuition is permitted. Children may attend additional days for days missed due to illness if parents arrange this with teachers.

Special Needs Students with undiagnosed ADD/ADHD, Asperger's/Autism, learning disabilities, or other developmental concerns, will be requested to seek professional testing and have that documentation on record with us and an IEP (individual educational plan) in place. We reserve the right to not accept a student when testing is not done and/or we cannot meet the educational needs of any student. Depending on additional level of educational service, tuition may need to be adjusted.

## PARENTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO PROVIDE:

Basic classroom supplies for each enrolled child (one time only at beginning of each year)

Field Trip fees (and transportation with parent or designated adult)

A healthy daily snack and occasional supplies for special cooking/art projects.

## CLASS OFFERINGS FOR THIS YEAR:

PRESCHOOL/PREKINDERGARTEN, 8:30-11:45 Mon-Fri (5 days available)

Age 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  recommend 2 days/wk

Age 3 recommend 3 days/wk

Age 4 require 4 days/wk to meet basic kindergarten readiness skill levels

Age 4+ requires 5 days/wk to guarantee kindergarten readiness for CCA

Lunch Bunch offered daily 11:50-1:00 (\$5 per child per day for part-time Preschool & Pre-K)
